35TH ANNIVERSARY MEETING

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 **ANNOUNCEMENT.** The Yorkshire Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club Ltd will organise a National B Permit Speed Hillclimb on 13th September 1997 using the short course at Harewood Avenue, Harewood, Leeds.
- 2 **STATUS.** The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the RAC Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3 **PERMIT.** RACMSA Permit Number: To be advised
- 4 **PERSONS ELIGIBLE.** The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club. BARC, ANCC and ANECCC.
- 5 All drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card at signing on.
- 6 **PROGRAMME.** Signing on and scrutineering will start at 08.00, any competitor not signed on by 10.00 may be excluded. Practice will start at 09.00 followed by the timed runs.
- 7 **COURSE.** The length of the course is 996.67 metres and consists of three left-hand corners and three right-hand corners. The road surface is smooth tarmac and concrete. RAC Track Licence number 31 has been issued for 1997
- 8 **CLASSES.**

All vehicles will comply with the RACMSA Technical Regulations E13 and, except as modified in these regulations, L.10 to L.12 as published in 1997 edition of the RAC Motor Sports Association Yearbook and any subsequent revision issued by RACMSA.

Vehicles in classes A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K and L must comply with L.10 to L.12.

9 AWARDS. Awards will be presented as follows:

Fastest time of the day

Fastest time in each class

No competitor may win more than one of these awards.

In addition all competitors will be given a souvenir of the event.

10 ENTRIES. The entry list opens on publication of the publications of the Regulations and closes on 22nd August 1997 or when the maximum entry is received if earlier. The entry fee is £55.00 for members of the organising club and £65.00 for all others. A late entry fee of an additional £10.00 is payable if the entry is received after 22nd August 1997. All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee

12 The maximum entry for the meeting is 150 cars

The minimum entry for the meeting is 80 cars

The minimum for each class is 4

Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis.

Should any of the minimum figures above not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

Entry Fees may be refunded in full to those entrants who withdraw before 17.00 on closing date. A refund of entry fee less a £10.00 administration fee may be made if notice of withdrawal is received before 17.00 on Wednesday 10th September 1997.

14 RESULTS. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Prize giving will follow when the results become final.

15 PROCEDURE. Cars will start singly in Class order. The starting signal will be a green light, method of timing will be electronic (Class E) from breaking a beam at the Start to breaking a beam at the Finish. The Finish line will be indicated by a line across the road

16 PRACTICE. All competitors will have the opportunity of at least two practice runs followed by three timed runs which will be taken in class order unless it appears to the organisers that the published timetable cannot be completed by 1800 hours.

17 IDENTIFICATION. Competitors will be identified by Competition Numbers which will be on sale at signing on. When two drivers compete in the same car the second driver will be identified by a letter A after the number one's competition number.

18 GENERAL REGULATIONS. Except as modified above, all Regulations in the 1997 BARC Yorkshire Centre Regulations Booklet and the General Regulations of the RAC Motor Sports Association apply as written.
