SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 **ANNOUNCEMENT.** The Yorkshire Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Permit Speed Hillclimb on Sunday 24th March 2002 at Harewood Avenue, Harewood, Leeds.
- 2 **STATUS.** The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3 **PERMIT.** MSA Permit Number: To be announced
- 4 **PERSONS ELIGIBLE.** The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club.
- 5 All drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card at signing on.
- 6 Practice times will not be published but will be available for information.
- 7 **PROGRAMME.** The programme of the meeting will be Scrutineering starts at 09.00hrs, any competitor not signed on by 12.00hrs may be excluded. Practice starts at 10.00hrs on 24th March 2002.
- 8 **COURSE.** The length of the course is 1448.25 metres and consists of four left-hand and seven right-hand corners. The road surface is smooth tarmac and concrete. MSA Track Licence number TBA has been issued for 2002.
- 9 **CLASSES.** There will be no classes.
All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations. All cars must be fitted with timing struts in accordance with SR.L.10.12.1
- 10 **AWARDS.** There will be no awards

- 11 **ENTRIES.** The entry list opens on 1st February 2002 and closes on 15th March 2002 or when the maximum entry is received if earlier. The entry fee is £72.00 per car. All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. **Entries will only be accepted on FULLY COMPLETED forms.**
- 12 Maximum number of two drivers per car. An entry fee of £30.00 to cover insurance and administration will be charged for the second driver. Entry forms **MUST** be completed by both drivers.
