On page two after R.H. (Richard) Jones I show I.A.S. (Irvine) without a surname. This should read I.A.S. (Irvine) Laidlaw. Further down on the same page Roy Light with a Mk.2 Midget fitted with a 1275c.c. engine is shown as in Class 6. Because of the substitution of the bigger engine this car should be in Class 9. I suppose there will be another crop in this list - sorry.
