FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you very much indeed for your entry for the "Snow Drift" Rally. Your number and starting time are shown in the enclosed list of competitors which, owing to postal delays, is certainly not complete.

Please be at the Start at the Hazel Bush Cafe on the York/Malton Road A.64 97/995582 in time to sign on and collect your route details at least fifteen minutes before your starting time. You will be handed the timing card as you actually start on the event.

Petrol, Meals or Light Refreshments are available at the start and finish point at the Hazel Bush Cafe. The first car should finish just after 4.00p.m. and results will be announced soon after the last car has finished.

The course is just over 120 miles in total length and will all be on route card. In some places arrows will be used to supplement route card instructions where confusion could occur.

There is no penalty for early arrival at time controls other than for exceeding a 40m.p.h. average.

Route Checks may be operated at points along the route.

The open road sections are arranged so that "dicing" is not necessary and will be frowned upon. Do please remember that other people have a right to use the highways and Sunday motorists usually drive on the wrong side of the road.

We have tried to keep well away from habitation, but where the route does pass houses, please behave in a sensible and courteous manner.

Finally, the "Snow Drift" is a new venture on our part, the main spirit behind the organisation is to give a pleasant social day out at a time when normally we have been inactive. Whilst the competitive parts of the event will obviously be taken fairly seriously, we do hope that all competitors will realise that these are only isolated sections of the competition and the linking parts of the route are to be taken as a happy social run and not as a junior Mille Miglia.
