IMPORTANT

MARSHALS

Marshals are particularly requested to arrive early on Saturday. We have arranged for extended practice to enable you to enjoy a full day's motor sport and those marshals signed on by 9.30am on Saturday will be entitled to additional subsistence (cash or marshals stamps).

SCRUTINEERING

For all cars, scrutineering will be carried out in the scrutineering tent adjacent to the beer tent. When a competitor is ready for scrutineering he should take his car out of the paddock, past the cattle-grid into the hilltop enclosure. An orderly queue should then be formed to enter the scrutineering area when called forward. After scrutineering, cars will re-enter the paddock directly from the scrutineering tent.

HELMETS

Helmets will be worn by all competitors at all times on the course. The paddock exit marshals will not allow any competitor out onto the course unless his helmet is fully secured.

PRACTICE

Practice will be strictly in class order with the exception that the first 40 competitors reporting to the Chief Paddock Marshal on Saturday morning will receive a third practice run ticket. These 40 competitors will take this run in the first two batches of practice.

TENDER VEHICLES

Tender vehicles must travel to the start via the paddock slip road and continue down the course. They must return to the paddock via the return road.

STARTING CARS AT THE START

The start line marshals are provided to control and direct the traffic in the start area. They are not provided to start competitors cars. It is the competitors responsibility to supply the personnel and equipment necessary to start their vehicle.

DRIVERS

Drivers are reminded that the paddock is a non-competitive area and cars must be conducted at walking pace when ENTERING and when moving about the paddock. Please give pedestrians due consideration and have regard for their safety. Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the meeting.

Competitors in classes 11 to 17 will receive a Paddock Window Pass. This allows a competitor to have one vehicle in the paddock during the course of the meeting and this vehicle must display the Paddock Window Pass. IT IS NOT IN ADDITION TO YOUR TRAILER. The trailer must be left outside the paddock in the trailer park. Display the pass on your tender vehicle window or access to the paddock will not be allowed. Drivers are reminded that your correct competition number MUST be prominently displayed on both sides of your car as per RACMSA Technical Regulations.

Drivers are reminded that driving competition cars on the public highway displaying competition numbers contravenes RACMSA Technical Regulations.

The start area is a designated part of the course and as such all persons under 16 years of age are prohibited from this area.

All competitors, officials and marshals are reminded that animals are not admitted to the Harewood venue.

Competitors attention is drawn to K.1.6.1 in the Blue Book:- Competition Licences must have a current photo of the holder.

Competitors attention is also drawn to K5:- Competitors and drivers are forbidden to abandon one event and compete in another
