** Signing-on and practice on Sunday is only available to those competitors excused Saturday practice and marked with an S in the list attached.

Drivers please note that an International or National Speed Competition Licence must be produced at signing on, along with your Entrants Licence, if appropriate.

To comply with the requirements of the RAC MSA we have to inform you that we are to use the extended course at Harewood for this event. The extended course will be 1584 yards long and will consist of seven right hand and four left hand bends. Other details are as indicated on page 92-13 of the 1992 Harewood Hillclimb Regulation Booklet.

H denotes Harewood Championship Entrant

**IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO MAKE PRACTICE STARTS OR INDULGE IN EXCESSIVE WEAVING
ON THE ROAD BETWEEN THE PADDOCK AND THE START LINE.
ANY COMPETITOR OBSERVED DOING THIS WILL BE LIABLE TO EXCLUSION FROM THE MEETING.
ALL COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO WALK THE COURSE PRIOR TO PRACTICE.**

THE APEX OF THE TWO CORNERS OF THE ESSES WILL BE CONED TO PREVENT COMPETITORS PUTTING WHEELS OFF THE TARMAc. THIS IS A TEMPORARY MEASURE PRIOR TO PERMANENT CURBING BEING INSTALLED DURING THE CLOSED SEASON.
A PENALTY MAY BE APPLIED AS PER REGULATION L9.8.5 IF A MARKING CONE IS STRUCK.

MARSHALS

Marshals are particularly requested to arrive early so that practice can commence to programme.

SCRUTINEERING

For all cars, scrutineering will be carried out in the scrutineering tent adjacent to the beer tent. When a competitor is ready for scrutineering he should take his car out of the paddock, past the cattle-grid into the hilltop enclosure. An orderly queue should then be formed to enter the scrutineering area when called forward. After scrutineering, cars will re-enter the paddock directly from the scrutineering tent.

HELMETS

Helmets and flame resistant overalls will be worn by all competitors at all times on the course. The paddock exit marshals will not allow any competitor out onto the course unless his helmet is fully secured and flame resistant overalls are worn.

PRACTICE

Practice will be strictly in class order.

TENDER VEHICLES

Tender cars may proceed to the start area with the competing cars and park OUTSIDE the start enclosure. You must return to the paddock by the public car park road.

MOTOR HOMES

Motor Homes may only be parked either in the trailer park or Motor Home park which is situated on the hard standing at the rear of the Hillside enclosure. In no circumstances may Motor Homes be parked on the edge of the hill in the public enclosure.

DRIVERS

Drivers are reminded that the paddock is a non-competitive area and cars must be conducted at walking pace when ENTERING and when moving about the paddock. Please give pedestrians due consideration and have regard for their safety. Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the meeting.

Competitors in classes 7 and D to L will receive a Paddock Window Pass. This allows a competitor to have one vehicle in the paddock during the course of the meeting and this vehicle must display the Paddock Window Pass. **IT IS NOT IN ADDITION TO YOUR TRAILER.** The trailer must be left outside the paddock in the trailer park. Display the pass on your tender vehicle window or access to the paddock will not be allowed.

Drivers are reminded that your correct competition number **MUST** be prominently displayed on both sides of your car as per RACMSA Technical Regulations.

Numbers will be available for sale at signing on

Drivers are reminded that driving competition cars on the public highway displaying competition numbers contravenes RACMSA Technical Regulations.

The start area is a designated part of the course and as such all persons under 16 years of age are prohibited from this area.

All competitors, officials and marshals are reminded that animals are not admitted to the Harewood venue.

Competitors attention is drawn to E.2.6.2. in the Blue Book:- Competition Licences must have a current photo of the holder.

Competitors attention is drawn to E.5.2. :- Competitors and Drivers are forbidden to abandon one event and compete in another.

INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFICIALS

Your attention is drawn to the following RACMSA regulations C5.2.18

The Clerk of the Course should relieve from duty any marshal or any other official who the Medical Officer considers as possibly unfit by reason of health, consumption of alcohol or drugs. Any form of doping is strictly forbidden including the use of alcohol.

INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPETITORS

Your attention is drawn to the following RACMSA regulations B20, B12.1.13., C17.2 & E10

The organisers may, at their discretion, exclude before during or after practice or competition any driver considered as possibly unfit by reason of health, consumption of alcohol or drugs. Tests may be carried out at any time by a Medical Officer under the authority of the Clerk of the Course.

Any form of doping is strictly forbidden including the use of alcohol.
