## **PLEASE READ THESE NOTES AND TIMETABLE VERY CAREFULLY**

### **MARSHALS**

Marshals are particularly requested to arrive early so that practice can commence to programme. Marshals signing on will take place in the Clubhouse. A strict one-way traffic system will operate from the paddock and return.

### **SCRUTINEERING**

All cars will be scrutineered at their allocated place in the paddock in batches in accordance with the Timetable.

### **DISPLAY OF COMPETITION NUMBERS**

Competitors are reminded of the requirement in the regulation E.12.3.11.

Numbers will be available for sale at signing on.

Drivers are reminded that driving competition cars on the public highway displaying competition numbers contravenes RACMSA Technical regulations.

### **MOTOR HOMES & TRAILERS**

Motor Homes may only be parked either in the trailer park or the motor home park which is situated on the hard standing at the rear of the hillside enclosure. In no circumstances may motor homes be parked on the edge of the hill in the public enclosure.

Competitors in classes 7 and D to L will receive a paddock window pass. This allows a competitor to have one vehicle in the paddock during the course of the meeting and this vehicle must display the paddock window pass. IT IS NOT IN ADDITION TO YOUR TRAILER. The trailer must be left outside the paddock in the trailer park. Display the pass on your tender vehicle window or access to the paddock will not be allowed.

### **LICENCES & MEMBERSHIP CARDS**

Drivers are reminded of regulation L9.2.1 regards the driving of cars over 2000cc whilst holding a National B licence.

Drivers requiring signatures for licence upgrading should leave their licence with the Secretary of the Meeting at signing on. The licence should be collected after the driver has completed his/her competitive runs.

Your attention is drawn to E.2.6.2. in the Blue Book :- Competition Licences must have a current photo of the holder.

Drivers please note that a BARC Yorkshire Centre Membership Card must be produced at signing on if you have entered as a Yorkshire Centre member, along with your RAC MSA Competition Licence and Entrants Licence if appropriate.

### **HELMETS**

Helmets and flame resistant overalls will be worn by all competitors at all times on the course. The start area marshals will not allow any competitor out onto the course unless his/her helmet is fully secured and flame resistant overalls are worn.

### **DRIVERS**

Your attention is drawn to E.5.2. :- Competitors and drivers are forbidden to abandon one event and compete in another.

Your attention is drawn to Q14.2 which relates to the warming of gearboxes in the paddock. At Harewood, due to the sloping terrain the Organisers do not consider it possible to safely suspend a vehicle in order to carry this out and this regulation is therefore modified. The warming of gearboxes in the manner described is prohibited. Penalty - Exclusion.

The start area is a designated part of the course and as such all persons under 16 years of age are prohibited from this area.

Drivers are reminded that the paddock is a non-competitive area and cars must be conducted at walking pace when ENTERING and when moving about the paddock. Please give pedestrians due consideration and have regard for their safety. Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the meeting.

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO MAKE PRACTICE STARTS OR INDULGE IN EXCESSIVE WEAVING ON THE ROAD BETWEEN THE PADDOCK AND THE STARTLINE. ANY COMPETITOR OBSERVED DOING THIS WILL BE LIABLE TO EXCLUSION FROM THE MEETING.

ALL COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO WALK THE COURSE PRIOR TO PRACTICE. PRACTICE WILL BE STRICTLY IN CLASS ORDER

**YOUR ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE FOLLOWING:-**

The Emergency Procedure described in para 11.2 of the BARC (Yorkshire) Regulation may be changed by the substitution of FLASHING RED LIGHTS for the Red Flag immediately before Quarry Corner.

**YOUR ATTENTION IS BROUGHT TO THE FOLLOWING:-**

Penalty markers will be placed on the outside of the safety kerbs through the Esses. Striking these markers may incur a penalty as described in RACMSA Regulation L.9.8.5

The order of running of shared cars will be as set out in 9.4 and 9.5 on page 95-7 of the 1995 BARC (Yorkshire Centre) Regulations Booklet and NOT as shown on their entry list.

Your attention is drawn to the following RAC MSA regulations L1.8.14.

The organisers may, at their discretion, exclude before, during or after practice or competition, any driver considered as possibly unfit by reason of health, consumption of alcohol or drugs. Tests may be carried out at any time by a Medical officer under the authority of the Clerk of the Course.

L1.16.1. and L1.16.2.

Any form of doping is strictly forbidden including the use of alcohol.

#### **TENDER VEHICLES**

Tender cars may proceed to the start area with the competing cars and park OUTSIDE the start enclosure. You must return to the paddock by the public car park road.

A FURTHER MERGING OF CLASSES MAY TAKE PLACE ON WEDNESDAY 10th MAY IF THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN A CLASS FALLS BELOW 4 DUE TO THE WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFICIALS**

Your attention is drawn to the following RACMSA regulations F.13.1.2.

The Clerk of the Course should relieve from duty any marshal or any other official who the Medical Officer considers as possible unfit by reason of health, consumption of alcohol or drugs. Tests may be carried out at any time by a Medical Officer under the authority of L1.16.1. and L1.16.2.
