### CLASSES

Competitors will be divided into the following classes :-

- Class 1a. Touring cars (open or closed) up to 1066 c.c. F.W.D.
- Class 1b. Touring cars (open or closed) up to 1066 c.c. R.W.D.
- Class 2. Touring cars (open or closed) 1067 to 1900 c.c.
- Class 3. Touring cars (open or closed) 1901 to 2700 c.c.
- Class 4. Touring cars (open or closed) 2701 c.c. and over
- Class 5. Sports cars (open or closed) up to 1066 c.c.
- Class 6. Sports cars (open or closed) 1067 to 1900 c.c.
- Class 7. Sports cars (open or closed) 1901 to 2700 c.c.
- Class 8. Sports cars (open or closed) 2700 c.c. and over.
- Class 9. Sports/Racing cars up to 1500 c.c.
- Class 10. Sports/Racing cars 1501 c.c. and over.
- Class 11. Formula Libre Racing cars.
- Class 12. Formula Junior Racing cars.

The promoters reserve the right to allocate Competitors to classes.

Supercharged cars will run in the next higher capacity class.

It is emphasised that these classes do not conform to either Appendix "C" or "J" of the International Sporting Code and the definition of a Touring Car, Sports Car, Sports/Racing Car and Special Car at the discretion of the organisers.

Each car may only be entered once in its own correct class.

Members of the Jaguar Drivers Club driving Jaguar Cars may optionally enter for the following J.D.C. Classes :-

- Class 1j. 1½ and 2½ litre saloons.
- Class 2j. 3½ litre and Mk V saloons.
- Class 3j. Mk VII, VIII and IX saloons.
- Class 4j. 2.4 litre saloons.
- Class 5j. 3.4 litre saloons. 3.8 litre saloons.
- Class 6j. XK120, 140 and 150 Fixed Coupes.
- Class 7j. SS100, XK120, 140 and 150 open and D/H.
- Class 8j. XK SS, C, D and E Types, Jaguar Eng. Cars.
- Class 9j. Ladies (in any Type of Jaguar).

The minimum entry in each Jaguar Class will be 5 cars, if less than 5 cars the class will be merged with the next highest class.

### GENERAL

For each run vehicles will be stationed with their front wheels on the Start line. Engines will be running and gears may be engaged. The "Course Clear" signal will be given by a green light and the competitor may then start in his own time. Timing will be recorded from the front wheels breaking a light ray at the start until the front of the vehicle breaks a light ray at the finishing line. Start and finish lines will be demarcated by a banner and a white line across the road.

Times will be announced on the loudspeaker system at the conclusion of each run. Fastest times to date in each class will be announced as each class completes the first and subsequent runs. Duplicated sheets giving all times will be distributed at the conclusion of the event
