#### **GENERAL**

For each run vehicles will be stationed with their front wheels on the Start Line. Engines will be running and gears may be engaged . The "Course Clear" signal will be given by a green light and the competitor may then start in his own time. Timing will be recorded from the front wheels breaking a light ray at the start line until the front of

the vehicle breaks a light ray at the finishing line.

Two timed runs will be allowed. The factest run by each individual competitor will count towards the final results and awards.

Times will be announced on the loudspeaker system at the conclusion of each run. Fastest times to date in each class will be announced as each class completes the first and second runs. Duplicated sheets giving all times will be distributed at the conclusion of the event
