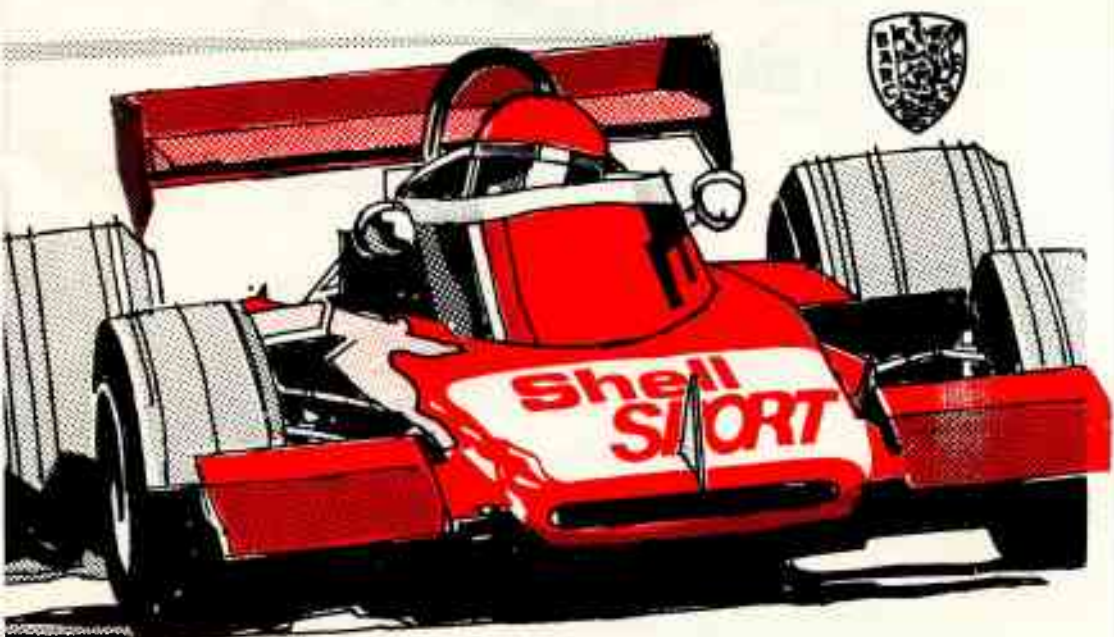

# B.A.R.C.

The British Automobile Racing Club was first formed back in 1912 as The Light Car and Cyclecar Club. In 1922 the name was changed to The Junior Car Club, and indeed for a number of years Club events were limited to cars of up to 1500 c.c., and the Yorkshire Centre was founded in Leeds.

Back in 1907 Brooklands Racing Track was built in Surrey and the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club was formed to run events at the famous concrete oval.

Between the two wars, both Club's made their names running motor races, but the J.C.C. in particular, got a reputation for exciting innovations in the motor sport calendar. Meantime, the Yorkshire Centre, in common with the Club's other centres, developed a local membership with a programme of road events, rallies, trials and a strong social programme.

During World War 2, Brooklands was taken over by the Government and the J.C.C. took over the remains of the old B.A.R.C. After the war the Club name was changed to the present British Automobile Racing Club as the historic J.C.C. name had become a liability.

Today the Club is the largest motor-racing club in Britain with it's own home circuit at Thruxton. The Club runs motor racing at Silverstone, Brands Hatch, Mallory Park, Donington Park, Culton Park, Snetterton, Cadwell Park, Lydden Hill. In the Yorkshire Centre we run the Hill Climbs here at Harewood and Race Meetings at Croft. We also have a programme of Social Events and a few road events of a social type. Our members also act as officials at Club meetings on other circuits.

Membership of the B.A.R.C. is in various grades. The basic membership fee for the Club is £6 per year which covers the Club as a whole, but without the right to take part in Club Motor Sport of the Racing & Speed Event type. Registration with the Yorkshire Centre costs an extra £2 per year and gives the holder the right to full participation in the Centre's events, administration, etc.

There is also a limited membership - Centre Associate which for a fee of £3.50 a year makes the holder a member of the Yorkshire Centre, but not of the main club. This covers participation in all Centre events other than competing in Hill Climbs and Race Meetings. A form for this type of membership is printed opposite.
