With an excellent entry of nineteen cars, the Castrol Ferrari Challenge class at Harewood today will probably be the biggest field of Ferraris at any UK hillclimb this season. From Martin McGlone's 212 Barchetta of the early fifties to the very recent 348 of Ray Ferguson, the class covers around forty-five years of Ferrari history.

Apart from the Barchetta, front engined V12 cars are represented by Martin Emmison's elegant 250 California and Richard Chester's 170mph Daytona. In contrast, there is a pair of V6 Dinos in open (spyder) form. The remainder of the entry consists of variations of the more recent 8 cylinder format.

Having their first tastes of hillclimb competition today are Ray Ferguson, Nigel Stubbs (from Selby) and Sally Maynard-Smith. They will be doing battle with a fine turn-out of regular Castrol Ferrari Challenge drivers from up and down the country. The man everyone wants to beat is BARC's own Simon Clark who holds the class record here in his 328GTS. He will be put under a stern test by local driver John Swift (308GTB) who leads the 1995 championship at the moment, Jon Goodwin in his astonishingly rapid Mondial t and current CFC champion Geoff Dark (308GT4). Also out to spoil his day will be the championship organiser Richard Allen with support from super smooth Brian Jackson and Christopher England, all in 308s.

But regardless of what Ferrari tipo they may be driving, you can be sure that all the drivers will be trying their hardest on this famous Yorkshire hill.

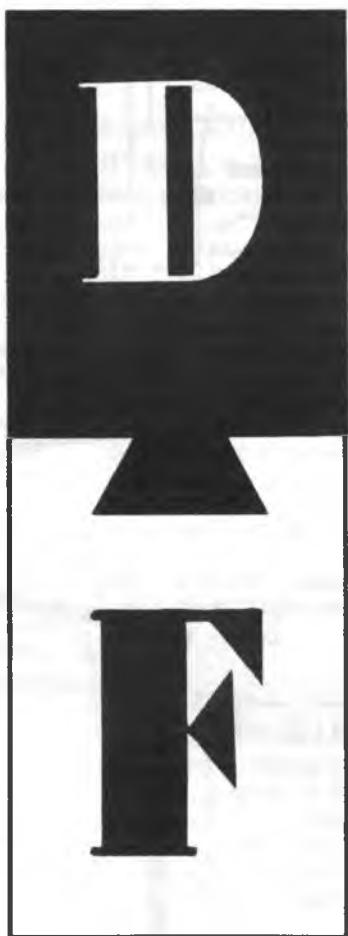
