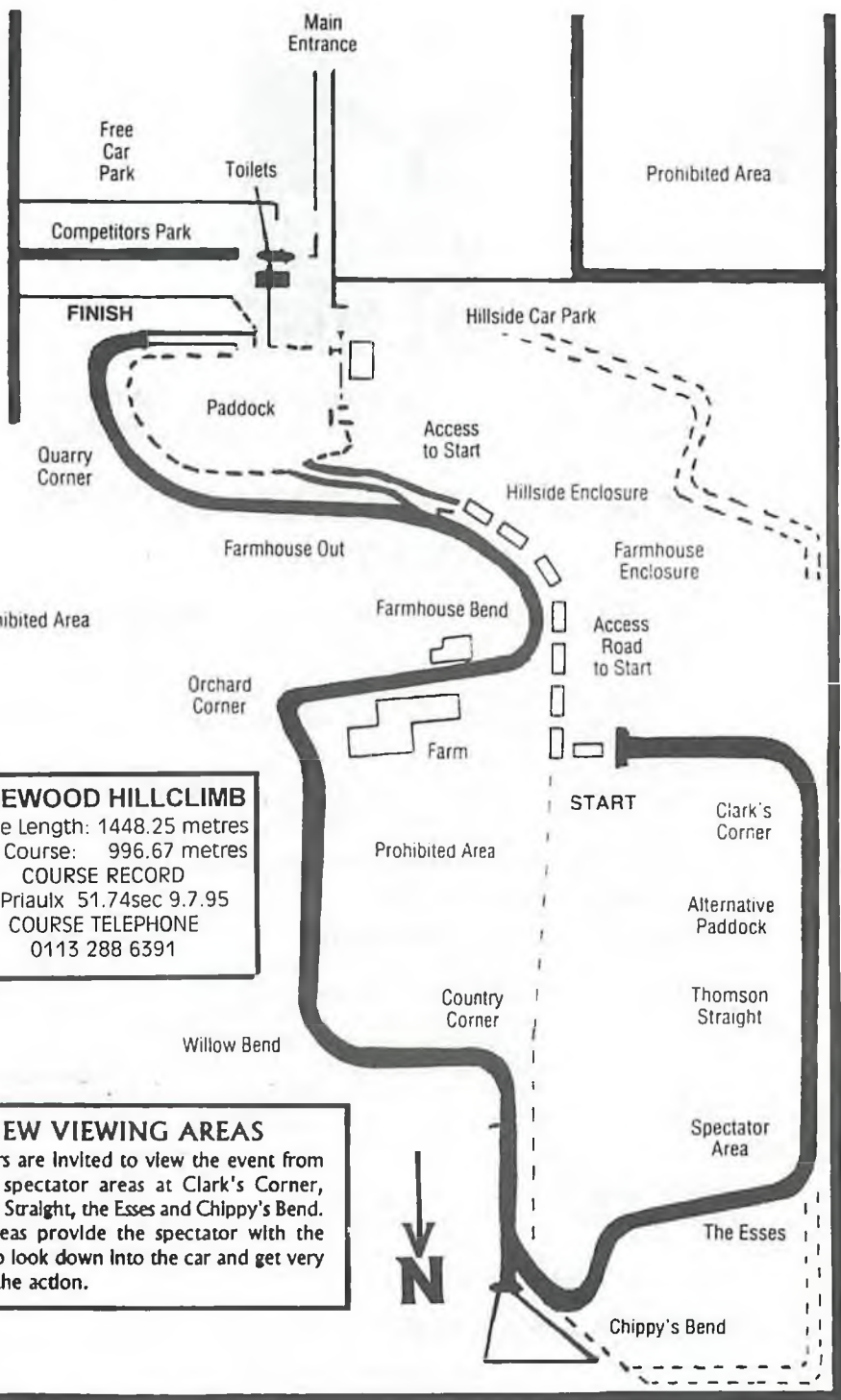

HAREWOOD HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP

Tony 'Tyres' Mekwinski is presently trying to snatch defeat out of the jaws of victory. In a previous event Tony has experienced a broken rear spring and at the last event he had 'three wheels on his wagon' when the wheel studs sheared and the wheel declared its independence. Fortunately car damaging as these escapades could have proved, Tony and his Escort have remained unscathed except for the odd minor dent or two on his less than pristine but rapid vehicle.

Tony's nearest rival prior to the last event, Dennis Crompton, went one step further when he put his BMW well through the hedge at Willow and consequently slipped from his secure second place in the Championship to, unlucky for him, 13th. Dennis will now have to fight back hard if he wishes to maintain his championship challenge. Three single seater drivers benefitted from Dennis' rush of blood to the head and the Formula Ford Reynard of class record holder David Bailey now holds second place. The Baileys are no stangers to second in the championship, David's father Ken having achieved this feat on previous occasions in the past.

Alan Aucote's 1100cc Terrapin has proved extremely competitive in the small racing car class but notwithstanding his car's small capacity Alan is presently leading the Harewood FTD Championship and 3rd in the overall championship. Stuart Abbott in 4th place desperately needs a high points score if he is to improve his position while in 8th place is another Formula Ford driven by Peter Hawkey. Over many years the Formula Fords have featured prominently in the top ten of the Harewood Championship. Saloon cars are making their presence felt in the championship this year and Harewood returnee Dennis Cope in the Mini Cooper S is presently lying 5th while Colin Stewart performs wonders in his historic MkII Lotus Cortina, his present 7th place is a fine reward for his stalwart efforts throughout this season. Barnsley driver Mark Brown holds 9th place in the Mini he normally shares with his brother Nick who was challenging for a possible top ten place but has failed to gain an entry for this event and so will slip down the leader board. Tim Wilson is roughly half a point behind 9th place man Mark so could improve his position if he scores a 15+ at this event.

Alan Aucote, despite having the smaller engine by far of all the major protagonists, also looks vulnerable as the big guns line up behind him, but Alan's present place is no fluke and he has attained this position on merit by consistent high points scores against much larger engined cars.

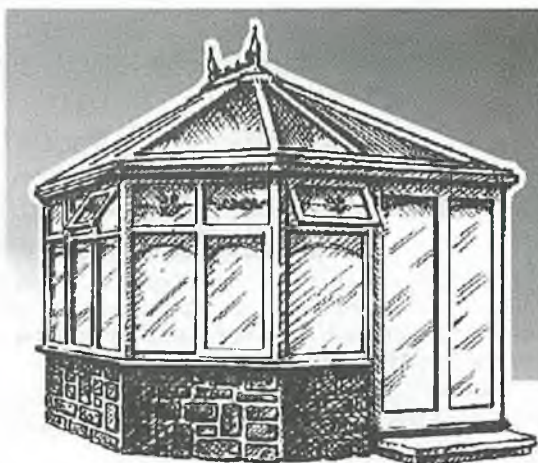

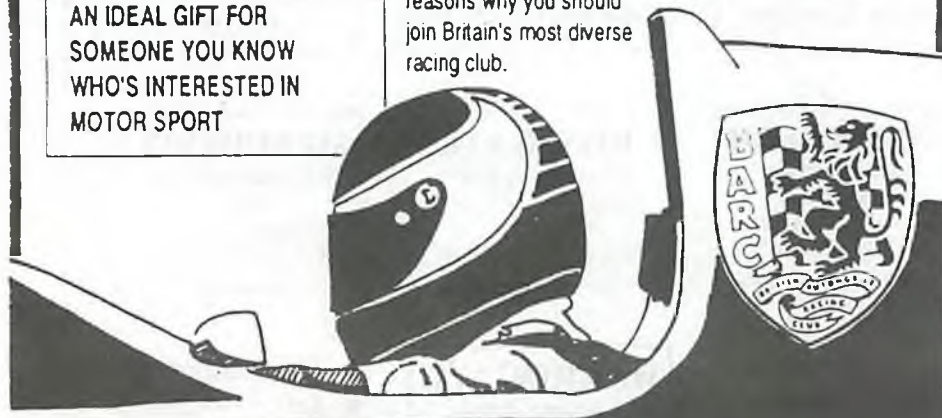
