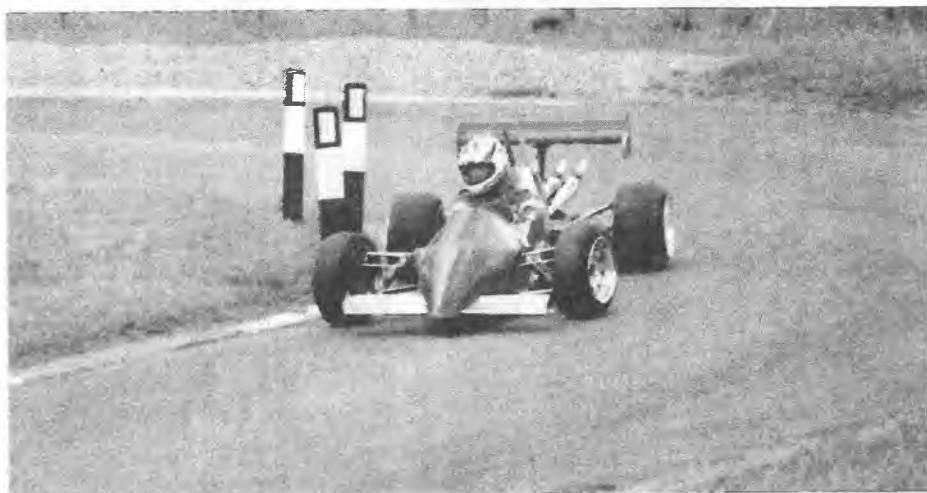

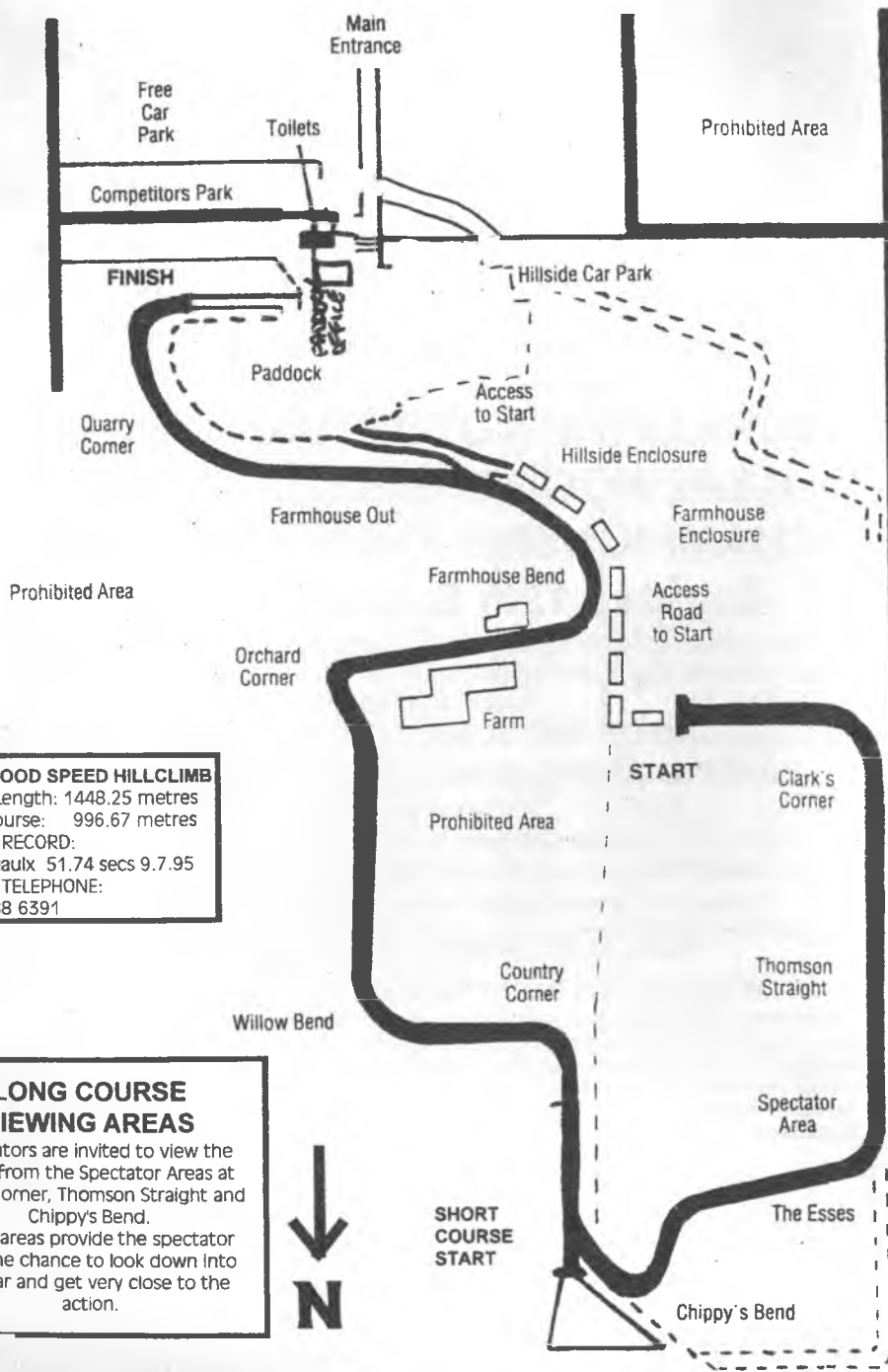

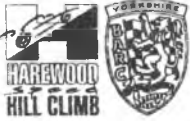

TAKEN TO THE CLEANERS

Two high points scoring rounds mid-season have virtually put Leicestershire driver Glyn Sketchley out of reach of his pursuers. The Jedi driver could be overtaken by the Richard Hargreaves Mitsubishi EVO 5 or the Clio Williams of Bobby Fryers, it would take record breaking performances of both these top saloon car exponents if they are to get on terms with the flying single seater driver. Glyn would have to have a disastrous day. Stranger things have happened.

LEADING CONTENDERS

Second and third placed Richard Hargreaves and Bobby Fryers have been locked in a season-long battle. Early in the season, Keighley driver Bobby Fryers' pristine Clio Williams had its nose in front but Richard Hargreaves has thrust the lurid yellow Mitsubishi into contention, now the Giggleswick farmer has a slender advantage over his near neighbour.

In fourth place the enterprisingly driven Sapphire RS Cosworth of Jonathan Mounsey is under severe pressure from the pretty Formula Libre Centaur of Huddersfield man Peter Green while Andrew Stokes is hot on his heels. Andrew, in his second season in hillclimbing, has forced the fleet Vauxhall engined Caterham into contention.

A shock could be lurking around the corner for these three drivers. Sheffield MG Midget expert Geoff Goodwin could overhaul the Sierra, Centaur and Caterham drivers in one fell swoop. Presently languishing in 19th place, Geoff has the advantage of no low score to drop, unlike his adversaries.

POSSIBLE INS & OUTS

From 7th place onwards, no-one is certain of retaining their place in the top ten, when they discard their lowest scores, they can be overtaken by those without points to drop. All drivers score on only 5 out of the 6 rounds. As they say, it's all to play for.

Without scores to drop Astra driver Daniel Pinder, along with Formula Ford drivers Mick Moore and Tony Metcalf are top ten contenders. Under threat are Scarborough Formula Ford driver Jonathan Rhodes, past Harewood Hillclimb Champion Dennis Crompton in his fuel injected, sequential gearboxed BMW 2002 Touring. Blackpool driver Jamie Hylton is presently leading the FTD Championship but could be dumped out of the top ten along with Nottingham Westfield driver Dave Banner.

All this of course depends on the vagaries of our British weather, but whether it's wet or dry, hot or cold, the action will be scorching.

MARKING SYSTEM

Marking will be within classes on a Bogey Time improvement basis. For the 1999 season the bogey times for each class will become 'floating'. The bogey time for each class will stay in force until the previous quickest time is beaten, the bogey time for the class will then be revised for the next meeting.

The initial 1999 Bogey Times will be the quickest class time at a BARC meeting during the 1998 season, with 18 seconds added.

To ensure that we have a worthy champion there will be a 'target time' for each class. A competitor must break this target time to be eligible to score a maximum of 20 points. A competitor not breaking this target time will only be eligible to score a maximum 18 marks no matter how much the bogey time is improved upon.

The target time remains active on these two classes only.

Championship marks will be gained at the rate of .01 mark for each .01 second by which a driver beats the Bogey Time for his/her class.

Marks gained in five of the six rounds will be counted for the Championship results.

There will also be 1 bonus mark for any competitor(s) who break the course record standing at the commencement of the meeting.

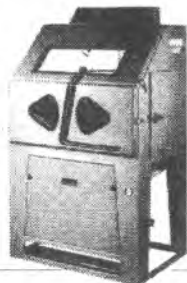

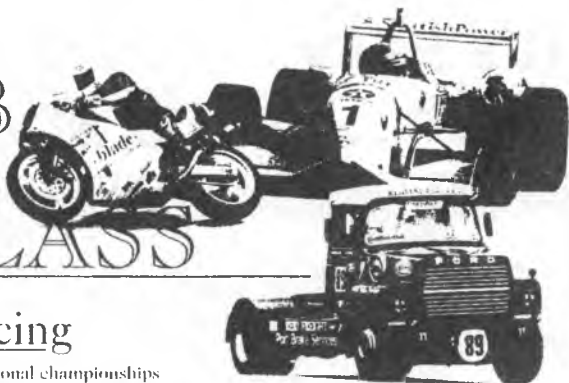
