# THE SEASON HOTS UP



Heading the stunning entry is multiple sprint champion Roger Kilty. The Tadcaster man, an ex-Harewood Hillclimb Champion is the class of the field, he is capable of recording Fastest Time of Day in his 600+bhp Pilbeam MP47 single seater. The attractive SPA sports racing car of Cheshire driver Christian Mineeff could upset Roger's applectart in the race for Fastest Time of Day. The gloves are off!

The event is Round 3 of the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Championship and the top positions are a Caterham/Westfield benefit. The leader, John Hoyle from Harrogate drives a 2 litre Westfield in Class 5 while last year's champion, Dave Banner in his similar but smaller engined car heads the Class 4 pack. The Nottingham man has Scalby driver Andrew Stokes' Vauxhall engined Caterham 7 and Menston driver Dales Cordingley's Rover engined Caterham breathing down his neck. Equal 4th is the first of the saloons, the spectacularly driven RS Cosworth Sapphire of Settle driver Jonathan Mounsey. Harrogate driver Robert Bellerby rounds off the top 5 in his Peugeot engined Sylver Striker.

In the top ten Yorkshire drivers hold sway. 6th to 10th is the 2 litre single seater of Steve Owen, who has Bobby Fryers from Keighley in his Clío Williams close on his heels. The full race Westfield of David Spaul (Leeds) is 8th while Boroughbridge fireman John Waggitt in his 2 litre single seater is 9th just ahead of Harrogate man Mike Geen in his 1500cc Sylver Striker.

Leading the FTD Championship is Steve Owen. The Leeds OMS constructor has a perfect points score to date while in the Ladies Championship Jenny Woodfield in her 2 litre Escort leads the way.

As well as our usual classes which cater for a Mini to a Formula 1 car, we have a fabulous collection of Lotus sports cars as well as a fantastic class of single seater and sports racing Lotus cars who are sure to put on a spectacular display of high speed driving.

The Caterham Academy is a 23 strong class which caters for novice drivers, and is sure to be spectacular in the extreme, as this for most is their first taste of competition driving!!

## **MARKING SYSTEM**

Marking will be within classes on a Bogey Time improvement basis. For the 2001 season the bogey times for each class will be 'floating'. The bogey time for each class will stay in force until the previous quickest time is beaten at a BARC (Yorkshire) organised meeting. The bogey time for the class will then be revised for the next meeting.

The initial 2001 Bogey Times will be the quickest class time at a BARC meeting during the 1998, 1999 or 2000 season, with 18 seconds added.

To ensure that we have a worthy champion there will be a 'target time' for each class. A competitor must break this target time to be eligible to score a maximum of 20 points. A competitor not breaking this target time will only be eligible to score a maximum of 18 marks no matter how much the bogey time is improved upon.

The target time remains active on these two classes only.

Class 1 70.49

Class C 61.17

Championship marks will be gained at the rate of .01 mark for each .01 second by which a driver beats the Bogey Time for his/her class.

Marks gained in five of the six rounds will be counted for the Championship results.

## **FTD**

At each meeting marks will be awarded to the championship competitors who have recorded the ten fastest times of the day in the class runs. Marks will be awarded on the scale 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 to the fastest competitor down to the 10th fastest.

There will also be 1 bonus mark for any competitor(s) who break the course record standing at the commencement of the meeting.

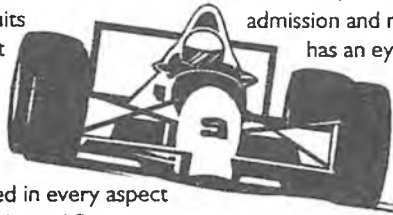

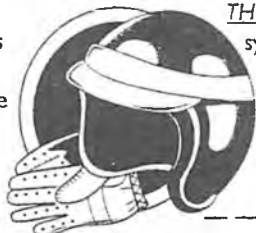
