



THE SEASON HOTS UP



The Championship is presently led by John Hoyle in his 2 litre Westfield SEiW. The Harrogate man is closely pursued by the 2000 Champion, Nottingham's Dave Banner in his smaller capacity Westfield. After this meeting competitors start to drop their lowest score. If applied now, it would alter the top ten dramatically. The Midget of Geoff Goodwin would be leading, as he has the lowest score to drop. Dave Banner and Steve Owen would remain in their present places but John Hoyle would drop to fourth. All will be hoping for a dry round today and at the final in September.

Local Leeds OMS single seater constructor and driver, Steve Owen, is mixing it with the leaders in the main championship. Not only does he hold third place, Steve is also leading the FTD Championship in his OMS racing car with a perfect score of 10 points at each of the 4 rounds held so far. It is difficult to see anyone toppling him from his present unassailable position.

Jenny Woodfield presently leads the Ladies Championship in her 2 litre Escort. Jenny has won the Ladies Championship for the past 3 years but is under extreme pressure from Lynn Owen who shares the OMS single seater with husband Steve. Clare Sullivan in her Mini would be up with the leaders except for a disastrous start to the season but may still come good as the season enters its most exciting phase. If at the start of this meeting we counted dropped scores, Clare Sullivan would be leading from Lynn Owen with Jenny Woodfield in 3rd place. As with the main championship, the outcome depends on dry final rounds - but it's all to play for.

Ferrari, the Magic of Maranello will be upheld by 16 of this most exotic of makes. The competitors in this class will all be driving their cars as Ferrari intended - fast. Ferrari Owners Club Championship is being led by Geoff Dark closely followed by Peter Hayman, Nick Frost and Mike Spicer. On scratch, Brian Jackson's F355 could be the quickest car but don't discount the Harewood experience of Nick Frost.

MARKING SYSTEM

Marking will be within classes on a Bogey Time improvement basis. For the 2001 season the bogey times for each class will be 'floating'. The bogey time for each class will stay in force until the previous quickest time is beaten at a BARC (Yorkshire) organised meeting. The bogey time for the class will then be revised for the next meeting.

The initial 2001 Bogey Times will be the quickest class time at a BARC meeting during the 1998, 1999 or 2000 season, with 18 seconds added.

To ensure that we have a worthy champion there will be a 'target time' for each class. A competitor must break this target time to be eligible to score a maximum of 20 points. A competitor not breaking this target time will only be eligible to score a maximum of 18 marks no matter how much the bogey time is improved upon.

The target time remains active on these two classes only.

Class 1 70.49

Class C 61.17

Championship marks will be gained at the rate of .01 mark for each .01 second by which a driver beats the Bogey Time for his/her class.

Marks gained in five of the six rounds will be counted for the Championship results.

FTD

At each meeting marks will be awarded to the championship competitors who have recorded the ten fastest times of the day in the class runs. Marks will be awarded on the scale 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 to the fastest competitor down to the 10th fastest.

There will also be 1 bonus mark for any competitor(s) who break the course record standing at the commencement of the meeting.
