



#### MARKING SYSTEM

Marking will be within classes on a Bogey Time improvement basis. The 2002 Bogey Times will be the current class record standing at the commencement of each meeting with 18 seconds added.

Championship marks will be gained at the rate of .01 mark for each .01 second by which a driver beats the Bogey Time for his/her class. Marks gained in five of the six rounds will be counted for the Championship results.

Any competitor who does not beat the Bogey Time will gain no marks for that meeting. A maximum of 20 marks can be gained at any meeting.

Marks can only be gained in the two class runs at the meeting on 6th/7th July 2002. At the remaining five rounds marks can only be gained in the three class runs except if a decision to the contrary is made at the end of the first timed runs,

#### FTD

At each meeting marks will be awarded to the championship competitors who have recorded the ten fastest times of the day in the class runs. Marks will be awarded on the scale 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 to the fastest competitor down to the 10th fastest.

There will also be 1 bonus mark for any competitor(s) who break the course record standing at the commencement of the meeting.





Over the past few years, Bobby Fryers in the Class 2 Clio Williams, has always featured among the leading contenders for the Harewood Championship. At the very wet June meeting Bobby was 2nd highest points scorer and took over the lead from Geoff Goodwin (MG Mldget) who has slipped to third. Tony Brumfield in his Sylva Mojo mastered the conditions in June and was highest points scorer and moved up to 2nd place.

Robert Bellerby, always a leading contender in Class 4, is presently in 4th place but will slip out of the top ten as he is not competing today. Clare Sullivan in her Mini was 2nd after the first round, has slipped to 5th, but could bounce back up the table.

After being so close to FTD at the last event, Andy Ball may find consolation today with a new class record given good weather. Jonathan Mounsey has completed a smooth transition from his Sierra Cosworth to Class 1 Citroen AX and heads Richard Vale's Class 5 Caterham. Class rival Matthew Sutcliffe holds 9th place ahead of the turbocharged Audi of Simon Bainbridge.



After an astonishing drive at the wet June meeting, Andy Ball set 2nd FTD, leading until the last runs. Andy will be hoping for a dry day today so that he can challenge the long standing Class A record and thereby get a big bag full of points for the Harewood Championship.
