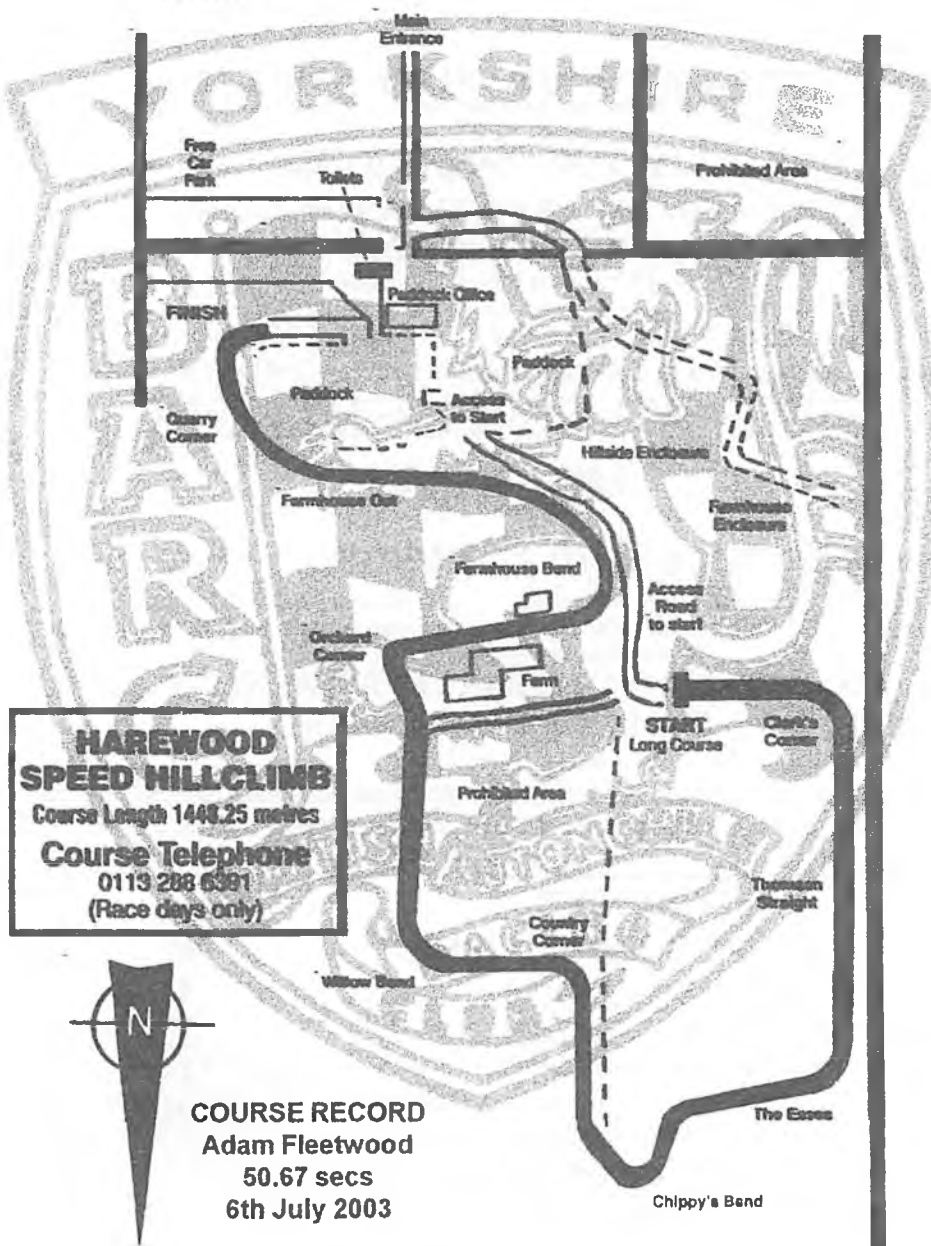

# GREENWOOD CUP MEETING

Saturday 13th September 2003



## Penultimate Round

The overall Harewood championship is finely balanced with Harrogate driver Mike Geen in his Class 1 1360cc Peugeot 205 having the meagre advantage of 1.38 points over fellow Harrogate driver James Blackmore who has reset the Harewood Class J (for up to 1600cc single seaters) record five times this year to Mike's six.

The Championship, which is based on classes, has reached the penultimate round with either of the above drivers likely to take the championship. Their nearest pursuer is Ilkley driver Dale Cordingley (Class 4 1600cc Caterham 7) who is nearly five points adrift. Robert Bellerby (Class 4 Sylva Striker) is fourth, a further two points in arrears. Rounding off the top five positions is Andrew Henson in the 2 litre Class K Pilbeam single seater. Andrew from Rochdale, despite setting 2 FTD's, will be extremely fortunate to improve his position.

### ***FTD Championship***

James Blackmore has a 3 point advantage over his nearest rival Andrew Henson, but as dropped scores come into play, if Andrew scores 10 points at each round he can win the title. At the moment the balance of power lays with James as he already has the points in the bag.

### ***Ladies Championship***

With both drivers missing two rounds, the Ladies Championship looks finely poised. Ilkley's Sarah Cordingley in the family Class 4 1600cc Caterham has a scant 0.06 lead but Clare Sullivan from Preston, a past Ladies Champion in her faithful Class 1 1380cc Mini has scored more points in the later rounds of the season. With just one more round to count and scores to drop, Clare would appear to have the advantage, but in motor sport anything can happen.

### ***Ferrari Class***

Alongside a full entry we have a special class for Ferrari road cars. York driver Nick Frost is a Harewood expert but it will be nip and tuck between Nick in his Ferrari 348 GTC and Richard Prior in the Ferrari 348 ts. Both drivers will be seeking points to help secure the Ferrari Hillclimb Championship. New driver Chris Butler was the sensation of the class when he placed his Ferrari F355 GTB in 3rd ahead of many more experienced drivers.

There will also be 1 bonus mark for any competitor(s) who breaks the course record standing at the commencement of the meeting.
