Welcome to Harewood



Harewood welcomes the Morgan Parc Ferme Speed Championship and two Porsche Championships on Saturday, alongside round 4 of the CG Motorsport BARC Harewood Championship.

Tracey Taylor-West leads the CG Motorsport BARC Harewood Championship in her Lotus Elise but David Marshall is close behind in the Peugeot. Paul Martin's *OMS* is a clear leader in the FTD Championship from Ed Carter.

The Avon Tyres/TTC Group MSA British Hillclimb Championship, returning to Harewood for the second time this year, has provided exciting competition with five different drivers taking wins so far. Reigning Champion Scott Moran broke the hill record at Harewood in May, breaking into the 48's for the first time. Alex Summers, Scott's co-driver this year currently leads the table on 122 points.

The new partnership of Wallace Menzies and Tom New is working well with both drivers scoring consistently in the ex Martin Groves Gould.

The two run-offs for British Hillclimb Championship points will form the highlights of Sunday's competition but expect stirring action too within the individual classes. If the weather is good a number of class records could fall.

The Avon Tyres/TTC Group MSA Hillclimb Leaders Championship follows the British series around the UK and the top drivers are all competing at Harewood today. The Championship is currently led by Colin Satchell with last years champion Jos Goodyear only 4 points behind.

On Sunday the Yorkshire Air Ambulance are at Harewood raising funds, we hope you will support them.

It all adds up to an exciting and competitive weekend's motorsport - we hope you enjoy it!



What is speed hillclimbing?

The challenge of *Speed* Hillclimbing is to drive the course in the shortest possible time. The faster drivers are those who can get the car off the start quickly, the first 64 feet can take under two seconds, and then find the quickest and smoothest lines through each corner. The fastest cars can complete the 1448 metre course in under 50 seconds, with speeds exceeding 130 mph!



Cars are called down to the start in class order. Where a car is shared by another driver, the second driver (their numbers will start with a 7,8 or 9), will go down to the start in the batch before the other driver. The entries are divided into classes, so that similar cars compete against each other. Each driver not only competes in his or her own race against the clock, but also against other drivers in cars of similar performance.

Each car carries a small vertical blade at the front called a timing strut. As a car approaches the start, the marshals line the car up immediately behind the timing beam. A chock behind the rear wheel keeps the car in the right position. When the driver is given the green light, they start in their own time. As the car moves forward it breaks the light beam and starts the electronic timing equipment.

At the finish line there is another light beam that stops the digital timing equipment for that driver's run. In addition to the start and finish timing beams, there are others that allow the driver to see their 'split' times at given points on the course after their run. These times are shown on the monitors in the Paddock Office entrance and also used by the commentator (see map for location of split time points).

If a car stops, slows or comes off the course, the marshals may show a red flag. This warns following drivers of a potential hazardous situation ahead. As a result a car may have to abandon a run through no fault of the driver and so will be given a re-run. If the red flag is given before Orchard the driver will return to the start via the road behind the barn. Otherwise the driver will continue to the finish, at a slower speed, then go down to the start via the slip road, to take the re-run.

Up to four cars can be on the hill at any one time. Timing is to the nearest one-hundredth of a second, a tiny amount, but one that can often decide a class win.

The ultimate achievement at each event is to establish the Fastest Time of the Day (FTD). This is usually claimed by one of the single seater racing cars, although wet weather can sometimes throw up an occasional surprise!

Explaining the classes

Here is a layman's guide to what the categories mean to help you understand what is going on. However, this is not a definitive set of rules – these run to numerous pages of fine print in the Motor Sports Association Competitors' Yearbook ("the Blue Book").



Road modified

Not less than 1000 of these saloon & sports cars must have been built each year. For kit cars etc this is 20 per year, but over 5000 of the basic engines must have been produced. These cars must be road going cars e.g. have tax and an MOT where applicable. Limited changes can be made to the body e.g. some parts e.g. the bonnet and boot may be replaced by other materials, but glass cannot be replaced by other materials. The basic silhouette of the car must remain, although some limited aerodynamic devices can be added. Interior trim must remain and all standard equipment must work. The engine may be modified, within limits. Tyres are limited to road going tyres from defined lists.





Modified production cars

Not less than 100 of these vehicles must have been made available through commercial channels in a twelve month period. The silhouette above the hub centres must remain unaltered, except for the bonnet and boot which may be modified. The bodywork may be made of different materials to the standard, but must maintain the original shape. The side and rear windows may be replaced with plastic. Modified front and rear spoilers/air dams are permitted. The engine must be identifiable as that fitted to the original model, but extensive modifications are allowed. Suspension changes are allowed with limitations. Slick racing tyres may be used.

Formula Ford

Formula Ford cars are cars built for a specific race series to ensure tight competition and to make sure that it is driver ability that shines through and not the size of their wallets. Harewood regulations stipulate that cars in this class must be built before 1994. The means that the engines are all Ford Kent type engines. Engine modifications are very tightly controlled/limited, as are suspension changes etc. No aerodynamic wings are allowed and tyres are also limited.

Sports Libre

Libre in French means free. In this category of cars the competitor is free to make a wide range of modifications and enter a wide range of cars not covered by other categorise e.g. World rally cars, hillclimb supersport cars, GT1 sports cars etc. Tyre choice is open to the competitor.





Racing cars

Single seat open wheel race cars. There is no minimum level of production. Engine choice and modifications are not limited. Aerodynamic devices are also allowed. Tyre choice is open to the competitor.



Championships

Main championship

Marking is within classes, based on the improvement against the bogey time. The 2015 bogey times are the current class record at the start of each meeting with 20 seconds added, with the exception of classes 1F, 2A, 2B and 2D which are calculated. Championship marks are gained at the rate of 0.01 points for each 0.01 seconds by which the driver beats the bogey time of his or her class. A maximum of 21 marks can be gained at any meeting.

Any competitor who does not beat the bogey time will gain no marks for that meeting. The three timed runs at each meeting will count, unless a decision to the contrary is made after the first timed run. Marks in six of the nine rounds will count towards the championship result (Note: The 10 May, 6 June and 5 July meetings are not rounds of the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Championship).

Fastest time of the day

At each meeting marks will be awarded to the championship competitors who have recorded the ten fastest times of the day in the class runs. Marks will be awarded on the scale of 10 for the fastest competitor down to 1 mark for the tenth.

THE BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO HAREWOOD

Coming to Harewood this time last year, the 'Scott and Trevor Show' was in full swing with former British champions Scott Moran and Trevor Willis beginning to dominate the championship scoreboard. This year there's a different pattern, with a newcomer to the very top echelons of British hillclimbing holding the number one spot on the series table since rounds three and four at Craigantlet, in Northern Ireland

Alex Summers is no stranger to the sport at top level, having finished in the top five for the last two years aboard his supercharged, bikeengined DJ Firehawk. But this year, his first in a big V8, he drives alongside defending champion Scott Moran in the most successful single British hillclimb car of all time, the Gould GR61X with 3.5-litre Nicholson McLaren power that took Moran to five British titles. At the time of writing he leads his mentor by a substantial margin on the series table, having beaten him twice and tied with Moran for FTD at Gurston in May.



That situation could change before today's meeting though, as this event is the second part of a championship weekend double-header. Yesterday's event, on the other side of the Pennines at Barbon Manor in Cumbria, was one of the five this year (ten rounds, with two run-offs at each event) at which Scott is not scheduled to compete. It's possible that 2012 champion Trevor Willis could have grabbed second place in the standings at Barbon in a year that has seen occasional problems for the OMS-RPE V8 driver. An exclusion for noise at Prescott's controversial opening rounds, a couple of accidents and a cracked gearbox casing at Doune have stemmed the hard-charging 2012 champion's progress this year and he'll be keen to take advantage of Moran's absence from Barbon.

Having now missed six of those ten rounds (which will be dropped scores in any case as only 28 of the 34 rounds are counted), Scott will be back in action today at Harewood, the venue where he scored his first run-off win twelve years ago in a V6 Pilbeam-Opel and where he set the current hill record just two months ago. He'll be determined to make up for lost time and increase his current 2015 total of five run-off wins and few would bet against it.

Already with one win in the bag, at a streaming wet Craigantlet, Will Hall is another potential front-runner at Harewood. On-going electronics problems, particularly with the car's launch control, have posed problems so far this year. But

once his Force with its new-for-2015 engine, the immensely powerful four cylinder turbocharged AER unit, is up and running it poses a serious threat to the championship leaders.

Hovering in the wake of the front runners are Wallace Menzies and Jos Goodyear. Both could spring a surprise today; Menzies with a new car engineered by his co-driver Tom New. It's the ex.Martin Groves, four-times championship winning Gould-NME (don't look for a pale yellow car - it's now in a much more 'racy' shade of Tillicoultry Quarries red!). Going into yesterday's Barbon round, Goodyear, the outright recordholder at Prescott and Le Val des Terres, had scored three FTDs in a row with his supercharged GWR Raptor-Suzuki and after a shaky start to the season is climbing back up the championship table. Fourth overall last year, he will be looking to better that in 2015.



Tom New and Alastair Crawford are currently enjoying a duel in their Gould V8s, Crawford in the slightly smaller-engined version, while before Barbon it was John Bradburn and Dave Uren that rounded off the top ten. Bradburn in his ex.F1 Cosworth HB engined GR55 and Uren in the very different turbocharged Force-Suzuki. Despite an unfortunate accident apiece at the last couple of events - in the hands of Dave at Shelsley, and his co-driver Nicola Menzies at Doune - after much toil by indefatigable constructor Ian Dayson both drivers should be back in action at Harewood today.

Waiting in the wings just outside the current top ten are Paul Haimes and Ed Hollier, Haimes' progress has been blunted during a problematic year with his turbocharged Gould GR59 and the former Harewood 2-litre record-holder will be anxious to make up for lost time. Rapid westcountryman Hollier has had a tremendous season so far in the least powerful car in the lineup, his 1600cc Empire Evo-Suzuki, and will be looking for more run-off opportunities here today.

A number of other drivers will be bidding for places in the two, all-important, British championship shoot-outs. With just the twelve fastest contenders in each set of class runs eligible to take part, the competition will indeed be fast - and furious.




