SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 The Yorkshire Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club Ltd will organise a National B Permit Speed Hillclimb on Saturday 2 June 2007 at Harewood Avenue, Harewood, Leeds.
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event including the regulations published in the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Regulations Booklet 2007.
- 3 MSA Permit Number: To be announced
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, BARC, VSCC, ANCC, ANWCC, HSA, MGCC, Pre-war Austin 7 Club, Morgan SCC, AMOC, HSCC and entrants in the Paul Matty Sportscar Lotus Championship.
- 5 All drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card at signing on.
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be as published in the Final Instructions.
- 7 The length of the course is 1448.25 metres and consists of four left-hand and seven right-hand corners. The road surface is smooth tarmac and concrete. MSA Track Licence number TBA
- 8 The event will consist of the following classes:
 - Standard and modified pre-1941 sports cars
 - 1 up to 750cc unsupercharged
 - 2 751 – 1100cc unsupercharged and up to 750cc supercharged
 - 3 1101 – 1500cc unsupercharged and up to 1100cc supercharged
 - 4 1501 – 2000cc unsupercharged and up to 1500cc supercharged
 - 5 2001 – 3000cc unsupercharged and up to 2000cc supercharged
 - 6 over 3000cc unsupercharged and over 2000cc supercharged
 - Special pre-1941 sports cars
 - 7 up to 1100cc unsupercharged and up to 750cc supercharged
 - 8 1101 – 1500cc unsupercharged and up to 1100cc supercharged
 - 9 1501 – 3000cc unsupercharged and up to 2250cc supercharged
 - 10 over 3000cc unsupercharged and over 2250cc supercharged
 - Pre-1941 Racing cars
 - 11 up to 1100cc
 - 12 1101 – 1500cc
 - 13 1501 – 3000cc
 - 14 over 3000cc
 - Edwardian cars
 - 15 Non- automobile engined
 - 16 Automobile engined

- 17 Classic saloon cars built up to and including 1971
- 18 Classic sports cars built up to and including 1971
- 19 Classic racing and sports racing cars built up to and including 1971

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations. Vehicles in classes 1 – 16 must also comply with the VSCC's Eligibility of Cars (2002) leaflet; an Eligibility 2000 Document for the car must be presented at signing-on.

The following MSA Regulations are modified:

E12.13.3 Any fuel may be used by racing cars in classes 11 to 14. In other classes, a fuel available at garage pumps must be used.

E12.14.3 Cars in classes 1 to 10 must be road equipped, with working headlights, sidelights and tail lights.

J20.7.1 Spare wheels must be removed.

L9.1.7 All competing cars must have a valid MSA or VSCC log book, unless competing in a road-going class.

Slick tyres are not allowed.

Cars must be silenced as MSA regulations for hillclimbs.

9 Awards will be presented as follows:

- Fastest Time of the Day
- 1st in class (subject to a minimum of 4 entries in class)
- 2nd in class (subject to a minimum of 6 entries in class)
- 1st in class on handicap in classes 1 to 16 (subject to a minimum of 4 entries, based on best % improvement on handicap)

10 The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes on 11 May 2007. The entry fee is £98 (£88 for BARC Yorkshire Centre members). All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

12 The maximum entry for the meeting is 120 cars. The minimum entry is 80 cars. Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis. Entry Fees may be refunded in accordance with SR13.7 in the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Regulations Booklet.

14 Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the end of the event and posted within 7 days. Handicap results will only be available when results are posted.

15 Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a green light, method of timing will be electronic (Class E) from breaking a beam at Start to breaking a beam at Finish. The Finish line will be indicated by a line across the road.

16 Competitors will be identified by Competition Numbers which will be available to purchase at signing on.
