**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

- 1 The British Automobile Racing Club (Yorkshire Centre) will organise a National B Permit Speed Hillclimb on Saturday 5 June 2010 at Harewood Avenue, Harewood, Leeds.
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event including the regulations published in the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Regulations Booklet.
- 3 MSA Permit Number: To be announced
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, BARC, VSCC, HSA, Morgan SCC, Bentley Drivers Club, Pre-war Austin Seven Club and the TR Register
- 5 All drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card at signing on.
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be as published in the Final Instructions.
- 7 The length of the course is 1448.25 metres and consists of four left-hand and seven right-hand corners. The road surface is smooth tarmac and concrete. MSA Track Licence number TBA
- 8 The event will consist of the following classes:
  - Standard and modified sports cars**
    - V1 up to 750cc unsupercharged
    - V2 751 – 1100cc unsupercharged and up to 750cc supercharged
    - V3 1101 – 1500cc unsupercharged and up to 1100cc supercharged
    - V4 1501 – 2000cc unsupercharged and up to 1500cc supercharged
    - V5 2001 – 3000cc unsupercharged and up to 2000cc supercharged
    - V6 over 3000cc unsupercharged and over 2000cc supercharged
  - Special sports cars**
    - V7 up to 1100cc unsupercharged and up to 750cc supercharged
    - V8 1101 – 1500cc unsupercharged and up to 1100cc supercharged
    - V9 1501 – 3000cc unsupercharged and up to 2250cc supercharged
    - V10 over 3000cc unsupercharged and over 2250cc supercharged
  - Pre-1941 Racing cars**
    - V11 up to 1100cc
    - V12 1101 – 1500cc
    - V13 1501 – 3000cc
    - V14 over 3000cc
    - V15 Non- automobile engined cars
  - Classic Cars**
    - C16 Classic saloon cars built up to and including 1971
    - C17 Classic sports cars built up to and including 1971
    - C18 Classic racing and sports racing cars built up to and including 1971
    - C19 Classic racing and sports racing cars built up to and including 1985

### Other Classes

19a Pre-war Austin Seven Club—Road

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations. Vehicles in classes V1 – V15 must also comply with the VSCC's Eligibility of Cars (2002) leaflet; an Eligibility 2000 Document for the car must be presented at signing-on.

The following MSA Regulations are modified:

C(b)19 Any fuel may be used by racing cars in classes V11 to V14. In other classes, a fuel available at garage pumps must be used.

C(b)20 Cars in classes V1 to V10 must be road equipped, with working headlights, sidelights and tail lights.

I25 All competing cars must have a valid MSA or VSCC log book, unless competing in a road-going class.

Spare wheels must be removed

Cars should be silenced as MSA regulations for hillclimbs.

9 Awards will be presented as follows:

- Fastest Time of the Day—Classic
- Fastest Time of the Day—Vintage

- 1<sup>st</sup> in class (subject to a minimum of 2 entries in class)

- 2<sup>nd</sup> in class (subject to a minimum of 6 entries in class)

- 3<sup>rd</sup> in class (subject to a minimum of 10 entries in class)

Awards will be presented at the end of the meeting, please make arrangements for some one to collect your award if you are unable to stay for the presentation.

10 The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes on 14 May 2010. The entry fee is £105 (£93 for BARC Yorkshire Centre members). All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

12 The maximum entry for the meeting is 120 cars. The minimum entry is 80 cars. Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis. Entry Fees may be refunded in accordance with SR15.7 in the Harewood Speed Hillclimb Regulations Booklet 2010.

13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the end of the event.

14. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a green light, method of timing will be electronic (Class E) from breaking a beam at Start to breaking a beam at Finish. The Finish line will be indicated by a line across the road.

15. Competitors will be identified by Competition Numbers which will be available to purchase at signing on.

16. Awards will be presented at the end of the meeting after the results have been declared final, and will not be posted after the event. If the award winner is unable to collect their award someone may be nominated to collect it on their behalf. Awards will not be held for collection at a later event.
