

Another for Martin

ANOTHER winning run from Martin Bolsover and two new class records were the highlight of the penultimate round of the Harewood Hillclimb Championship in Yorkshire last Sunday, run by the BARC (Yorkshire Centre).

Bolsover's winning time of 36.83s in his Guyson International Pilbeam-Hart MP51, was over half a second up on Roy Lane's BMW powered Pilbeam. With Otley's Jim Thomson only managing third

spot, Bolsover is now joint leader with Thomson of the Shell Oils Harewood FTD award series. Both have 40 pts but Bolsover will count everything on the last round whereas Thomson has to drop his lowest score.

Brian Walker retook the lead in the Harewood Hillclimb Championship with another searing run in his Skoda-Hart. He smashed his

month old record of 41.75s reducing it to 41.47s and nipped past Paul Tankard at the head of the charts with 82.95 pts to Tankard (TVR Tuscan V), 82.69 pts.

Simon Clark set a new Formula Ford 1600 class best with 45.97s, clipping half a second off Tony Harris' old Record with his Van Diemen RS78. **D.H.**
